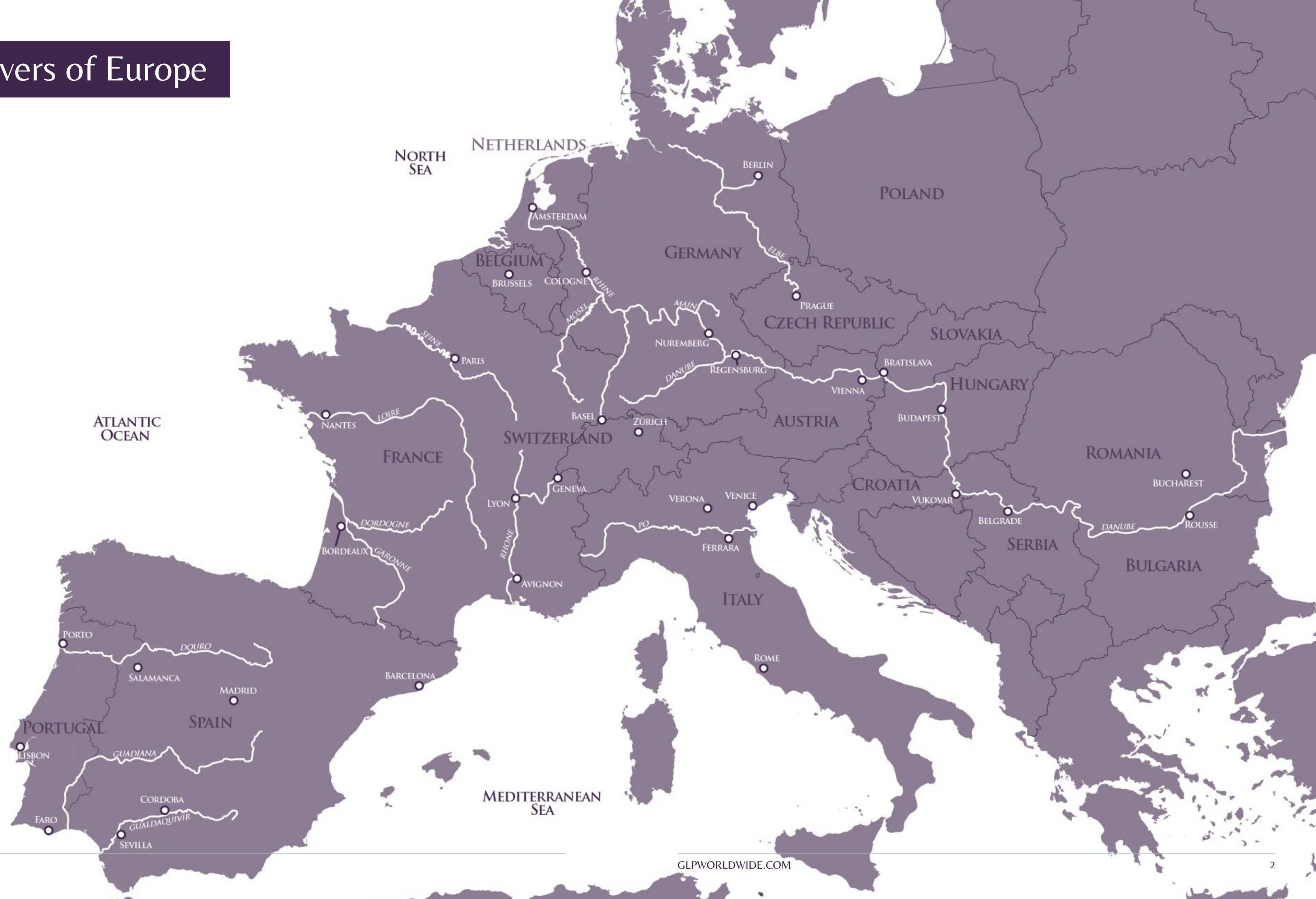

The Rhône

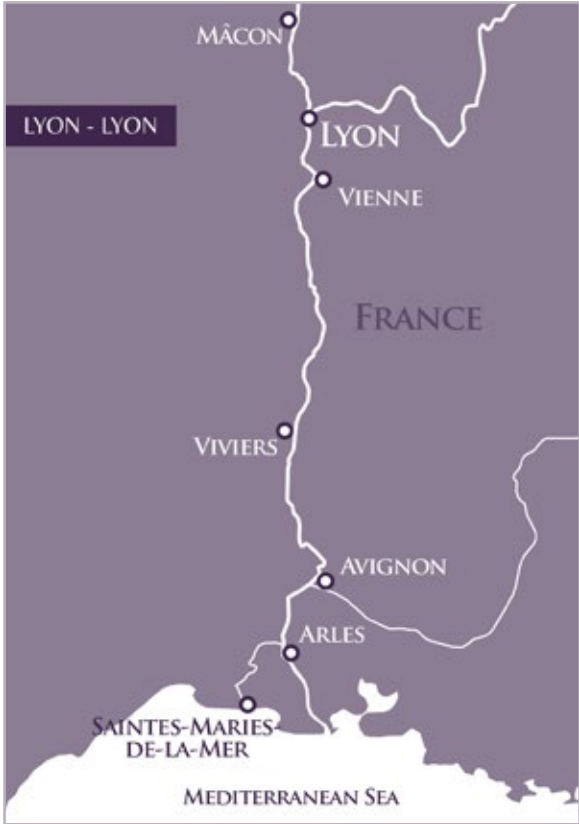
